More about the Australian Rural Education Centre

Pavilion One has a multi-purpose area of 30 x 15m and also includes shower amenities, toilets, commercial kitchen, cool room and 12 x 6m office / meeting room. Toilets include 1 disabled toilet, 7 ladies', 4 men's plus 3 urinals.

Founders Pavilion has an internal space of 60 x 30m with plenty of natural daylight. Several activities will be held here including night entertainment. It has a 6m veranda around the outside of the building. There are 10 ladies' toilets, 3 men's plus 4 urinals and 1 disabled toilet attached to this building. There are another four toilet blocks scattered around the AREC area.
